## TOPIC: MORSES POND DREDGING PROJECT

Dredging of the Pond's North Basin is the third and final major element of the Morses Pond Management Program to restore the detention capacity of the basin in order to alter/reduce rooted plant growth and reduce internal nutrients in the rest of the Pond. The project was funded by Town Meeting and the voters in 2007.

**Construction on the project is slated to begin in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of this year (2010).**

- The Town has offered to meet with the Pond stakeholders to review the dredging plan to-date, answer questions and listen to our input.
- You are encouraged to attend and learn more about the continuing work being carried out to improve our Morses Pond.

The Town's Morses Pond Management team has completed the competitive bidding and selection of the engineering firm, the analysis of the sediment materials, and most of the design and permitting process.

As this public meeting is taking place prior to a number of the final decisions, it is important to attend and to participate in the discussion.

This meeting will be attended by the Town staff involved in the project as well as the Pond's General Project Manager, Ken Wagner, and will also be an opportunity to ask questions on other elements of the Morses Pond Management activities.
